Unless otherwise requested, this application form is to be used by Seafish for new vessel compliance to Seafish Construction Standards in accordance with the Codes of Practice for fishing vessels less than 24m Registered Length issued by the Maritime and Coastguard Agency MSN 1770 (F) & MSN 1813 (F).

Please be aware that adequate notice of intention to build is required, with particular regard to GRP vessels. Accurate / realistic start and completion dates should be provided as required overleaf.

Drawings, specifications and lay-up procedures should be submitted well in advance of build commencement to enable plan approval and Marine Surveyors comments where applicable, failure to produce any of the aforementioned may be refused survey.

It should be noted that in cases where vessel outfit is completed elsewhere [refer to Tick boxes overleaf] and by persons other than the main Hull builders, that a separate Application Form is to be completed and forwarded by those responsible for that part of the construction.
