LANDINGS BY UK REGISTERED AND FOREIGN VESSELS, 2015



Note: Home port is defined here as the port at which a vessel is based.


Average vessel length (m)



Red outline indicates presence of vessels of 24m or over. Number of vessels 24m or over indicated here.


PRINCIPAL PORTS BY VALUE OF FISH LANDED, 2015
