

UNDER 16.5m SKIPPER'S CERTIFICATE APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL

Background

Our Under 16.5m Skipper's Certificate is issued with a five year expiry date. This form sets out our requirements for holders to renew their certificates.

1. Refresher training

Holders must re-attend Safety Awareness training where certificates were issued before 1st January 2012. You are being asked to do this because the Safety Awareness course launched in 2012 was very different from the original. It provides up-to-date information, advice and guidance on establishing and implementing safety management systems onboard fishing vessels. This course can be refreshed at any Seafish Approved Training Provider.

2. Evidence of current and relevant experience

Holders must provide details of their recent experience (over the last five years since their certificate was first issued) of taking charge of an under 16.5m UK registered fishing vessel.

Holders must also provide the name and contact details of an appropriate person who we can contact to verify these details (such as a Harbour Master, Fishery Officer, member of staff of the Maritime & Coastguard Agency, Secretary of a Producer Organisation or Fishermen's Association).

Why am I being asked to do this?

We have been criticised for awarding certificates to inexperienced skippers. In order to protect the integrity of this qualification and the reputation of those who hold it, we need to check and verify that certificates are only issued to experienced skippers.

3. Information

Holders must provide updated contact details and a new full-face, passport-size photograph.

4. Fee

Holders must pay £10 to cover the cost of administration, production and delivery of their new certificate.

Renewal Procedure

- 1) Complete and sign the application form overleaf, providing all the information required in boxes 1 to 6 and the attached feedback form.
- 2) Submit a passport-size full-face photograph, signed on the reverse. It should be attached either by staple or paper clip in the box on the top, left hand corner of the application form. The photograph will be incorporated within the certificate returned to the candidate.
- 3) Send the completed form, with photograph, payment* and completed feedback form, to the address below.
- 4) Your new Skipper's Certificate will be posted to you at the address you provide on the application form.
- 5) Please allow up to 14 days for your card to arrive
- *Please note you can either pay by bank transfer using the details below, please use you name as the reference or alternatively by sending us a cheque made payable to Sea Fish Industry Authority.

We may contact you from time to time to check and verify your information. We are obliged to share this information with the Maritime & Coastguard Agency and other relevant authorities on request.

We may also share your details with:

- any other training providers you might approach (to enable them to check whether you might be eligible for any funding for training and to inform them what other training you might need to undertake), and
- with the owner, managing agent and/or skipper of the vessel you are working on, or wanting to work on (to confirm to them what training you have completed).
