2020 UK/EU import and export summary introduction




- Combined the UK's total seafood exports to, and imports from the EU decreased in 2020 in terms of value and volume, whilst experiencing deflation
 - Seafood exports increased in volume whilst value declined, as the average £/kg fell
 - Seafood import value and volume decreased, whilst the average £/kg increased slightly
- Exports continue to hold the largest share of trade, however, exports' share of value trade has fallen slightly to 51.9%, whilst share of volume has increased to 57.2%
- With regards the EU's share of total UK seafood trade, exports increased their share, whilst imports slightly lost share to other countries.




