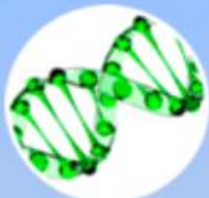

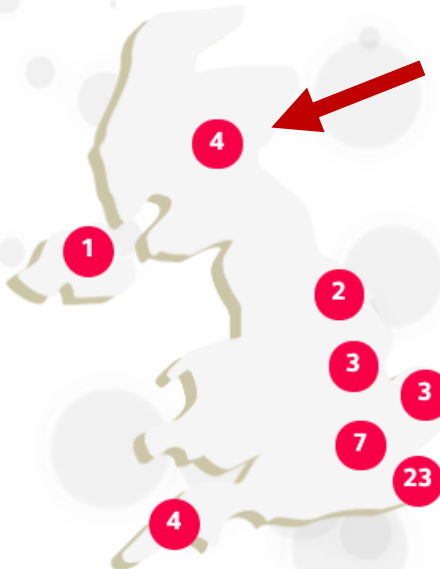

Proposed Landscape Map

List of research activity

A way of clarifying/keeping track of who is currently undertaking what aquaculture research and where so other researchers/research bodies are aware of what's being done around the UK:

- Highlight gaps in current research and help focus funding bids
- Prevent duplication of work
- Help collaboration/relationship building between researchers & industry
