• Automatic increase of an autonomous tariff quota. EU Official Journal.

According to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EU) 2015/2265, the volume of the following tariff quota is increased as follows for the 2017 calendar year:

• EU and Chile to start negotiations for a modernised Association Agreement. Source DG TRADE.

A first round of negotiations between the EU and Chile for a modernised Association Agreement will take place on 16 November, in Brussels. This follows the decision taken today by EU Member States to approve the mandate for the European Union to conduct these negotiations.

The aim is to update the 14-year-old EU-Chile Association Agreement to bring its political and cooperation ambitions and trade provisions into line with the EU's modern agreements. A second round will take place in early 2018.

Uruguay: Changes on labelling Requirements for Fish Products. Source DG TRADE

Specific labelling requirements as determined by the National Directorate for Aquatic Resources (DINARA) under the Ministry of Livestock, Agriculture and Fishery (MGAP) are to be met for fish and fish products to be marketed in Uruguay. According to the corresponding stipulations, labels of said products must be previously approved by the DINARA and imprinted, attached or adhered to the products or their packaging or wrapping. The following details must be contained on the labels in Spanish:

- denomination of the product with the indication of the common and scientific name or of the respective species which are contained therein
- o identification of the manufacturer
- o name and address of the authorised processing establishment
- o name and domicile address of the importer or distributor, as applicable
- \circ origin
- net weight, unless the container or label indicates that the content is to be weighted at the time of sale to the public
- ingredients of each package, when there is more than one ingredient, listed in decreasing order of their proportions
- o date of production
- o date of expiry

- o the words "inspeccionado por DINARA" (inspected by the DINARA; with regard to the product)
- \circ the words "aprobado por DINARA" (approved by the DINARA; with regard to the label)
- o Registration of Importers of Fish Products number.
- Fish in a new climate. Source Research EU.
