C188 – WORK IN FISHING CONVENTION, 2007

- 1. Minimum age to work onboard
- 2. Medical review prior to embarkment
- 3. Written contract:
 - Duration: 8 months maximum on board.
 - Salary (min. ILO), regular payment and pay slips copies.
 - Paid holidays and resting periods.
 - Medical coverage.
 - Indemnity in case of sickness, injury or death.
 - Social Security.
 - Repatriation.

C188 - WORK IN FISHING CONVENTION, 2007

- 1. Minimum crewing certification.
- 2. Occupational risk prevention:
- 3. On board evaluation plan.
- 4. Training plan.
- 5. Delivery and use plan personal safety gear.
- 6. One Risk Prevention officer per vessel.
- 7. Right to Collective Bargaining.







