

#### DIRECTIVE (EU) 2019/904 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 5 June 2019

on the reduction of the impact of certain plastic products on the environment

# **Singe-Use Plastics Directive\***

- Adopted 5<sup>th</sup> June 2019
- Only considers gears containing plastic
- Extended Producer Responsibility scheme (collection + transport + treatment + awareness raising)
- Fishers / artisanal producers not 'producers'
- Harmonised standards for circular gear design
- National collection targets (view to EU-wide target)

# **UK position**

The UK commitment to implementing the Single-Use Plastics Directive is now dependent on the new government
