Introduction

The Border Target Operating Model (BTOM) introduces import controls on goods entering Great Britain from the EU as part of new border policies following the UK's exit from the EU. Ports of entry for seafood imports will need to take account of these new requirements.

Checks on goods are based on their risk categories and seafood commodities can be categorised as high risk, medium risk or low risk. BTOM risk categories differ depending on whether importing from the EU or from the rest of the world (ROW). The EU BTOM risk categories apply to imports from the EU, EFTA (European Union and European Free Trade Association) countries, the Faroe Islands and Greenland, totalling 33 countries. A list of countries is provided in the annex.

Trade data detailing the volume of imported seafood products by port of entry is processed by Seafish and presented in this document. The UK imported 644,920 tonnes of seafood products in 2022 worth £3,637 million. Just over half (53%) of the volume imported was consigned from EU (EFTA +2) countries and the other 47% was from the rest of the world.

Low risk products account for 40% of seafood imports coming from the EU (EFTA + 2) countries and 9% of seafood imports from the rest of the world. All other seafood products entering GB for human consumption are of medium risk.

Over half of all seafood imports to Great Britain enter through the ports of Immingham and Felixstowe with the top 20 ports of entry accounting for 98% of all seafood imported to GB.

This report provides evidence to indicate the volume of medium risk and low risk seafood imports to top GB ports of entry.

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Trade data notes

The analysis in this report covers the seafood import volume (tonnes) to GB ports of entry. The most recent data available at the time of writing was used, which covers the 12-month period between November 2022 and October 2023 (provisional data). There are three tables presented per port of entry to cover:

- The volume imported to GB from EU (EFTA+2) countries and ROW (rest of world) countries.
- The volume of low and medium BTOM risk categories imported from each of the 2 areas.
- The top 10 species imported by volume from each of the 2 areas.

HMRC trade in goods statistics cover seafood products imported to and exported from UK ports and presented as 8-digit combined nomenclature commodity (CN8) codes. We process these statistics using the EUMOFA (EU Market Observatory for Fisheries and Aquaculture) methodology. This allows for analysis of the value and volume of main commercial species, species groups, preservation and presentation states traded with the UK by partner country. Published data is provisional for 18-months and subject to change over this time.

BTOM risk categories are provided by DEFRA on the government website. Risk category by commodity code is provided for imports from EU (EFTA+2) countries and by summary for ROW countries and New Zealand specifically. These risk categories were assigned to the combination of CN8 and country of consignment from UK trade statistics to produce the tables in this report. If the government website provided a "low or medium" risk assessment for a fishery product, where possible we assigned the most appropriate risk category on the basis of our trade knowledge. Where this was not possible, the product was assigned a medium risk.

The species defined in trade statistics are defined based on CN8 commodity codes. Some traded commodities may include products containing a variety of different species or groups of species, meaning that individual species can't be identified. This is the case for some commodity codes of certain shrimp and prawn products, which encompass both warm-water and cold-water species. Similarly, species groups titled "other" are products that don't have a unique CN8 per species. The group "Other marine fish" includes frozen raw fillets coated in batter or breadcrumbs, curry fish balls, frozen whole, chilled fillets of marine fish. These may contain a mix of demersal or pelagic species.

Import statistics extracted in this report should be interpreted with caution.
