

## **Terms of Use - Market Insight Data**

## Our market data sources and restricting access

Market data provided by Seafish is purchased from external data providers. We have contracts in place with each data provider that stipulate we must only share access to detailed data with levy payers or seafood businesses which supply seafood to the UK seafood market. This also includes trade associations that represent the interests of seafood businesses, and government. To share data with any other parties is a breach of our contractual agreements.

We carefully monitor any/all access requests and will restrict requests from individuals and organisations that do not fulfil the qualifying criteria. This includes (but is not limited to) consultants, non-levy paying businesses, media, agencies, education etc.

## Terms of use

Your use/continued use of the data indicates that you have accepted these terms and conditions in their entirety and without change. Seafish reserves the right to amend these terms and conditions. Notification of any such amendments will be posted on the Seafish website.

- Market information must not be resold for commercial profit or gain.
