Thanks to funding from EMFF and the Maritime \& Coastguard Agency, grants are available to reimburse experienced fishermen undertaking an approved programme of training.

To apply, you must complete this form and send it to Seafish at the address provided at the bottom of this form, prior to commencing any training. You will then receive a letter from Seafish advising on the outcome of your application.

If successful you can claim your grant when you have completed the training, by submitting a claim form with a copy of your course completion certificate and an original receipt evidencing that you have paid your course fees. Please note, however, that you cannot claim for any costs for which you have received (or will receive) funding from elsewhere.

## Eligibility - Please Read Carefully

You must be:

- aged 18 or above
- an experienced commercial fisherman who has worked on a UK-registered fishing vessel for at least 60 days within the last two years
- an experienced commercial fisherman who has completed all the required basic safety training courses (sea survival, first aid, firefighting, health \& safety and safety awareness)


## Data Protection:

Seafish and its Approved Training Providers have a legal obligation to keep a record of your personal details and any basic safety training that you have completed. Details of what information we hold for you are available on request (email us at training@seafish.co.uk or call us on 01472 252302). We may contact you from time to time to check and verify your information. We are obliged to share this information with the Maritime \& Coastguard Agency and other relevant authorities on request.

We may also share your details with:

- any other training providers you might approach (to enable them to check whether you might be eligible for any funding for training and to inform them what other training you might need to undertake), and
- with the owner, managing agent and/or skipper of the vessel you are working on, or wanting to work on (to confirm to them what training you have completed).
