

#### Responses to business performance questions by region & site size

168 majority<sup>1</sup> + minority processing sites responded to the business performance questions<sup>2</sup>.

This sample covered 40% of the population of minority + majority processing sites and 67% of 2021 survey respondents (minority + majority processing sites).





Business performance rating over the last 12 months UK level, (n=168)




Business performance rating over the last 1 2 months by home nation, (n=168)



Almost half of respondents reported below average or poor business performance over the 12 months prior to April 2021. Businesses in Northern Ireland and England had the largest proportions of negative responses, while responses from Scotland were more evenly split.



### Business performance by majority\* UK market type




A large proportion of majority 'foodservice' and 'wholesale' (likely feeding into foodservice) sites reported below average or poor business performance in the 12 months to April 2021. Businesses mainly supplying retail were the most positive about their business performance.


#### Factors affecting business performance (previous 12 months)



Businesses reported negative impacts of both Covid-19 and EU Exit on production, labour, raw materials, logistics and markets in the 12 months prior to April 2021. Covid-19 was reported by the most businesses to have had a negative impact on markets, while EU Exit was reported by the most businesses to have had a negative impact on logistics.




#### Factors affecting business performance (next 12 months)



Starting from April 2021, fewer businesses expected negative impacts of Covid-19 and EU Exit on business performance compared to the previous 12 months. Businesses generally anticipated a reduction in negative impacts related to Covid-19 in the next 12 months as restrictions eased in 2021. Logistics issues caused by EU Exit was the most cited expected negative impact on business performance for the next 12 months.




# Ceased, reduced, or increased operations at any point during January-March 2021 due to Covid-19 or EU Exit



During January-March 2021, 42% of respondents reduced activity due to Covid-19, while 14% of respondents saw heightened demand and increased activity due to Covid-19. 25% of respondents reported reduced activity during this time due to EU Exit. Fewer businesses ceased operating during the period as a result of either Covid-19 or EU Exit.



# Ceased, reduced, or increased operations at any point during January-March 2021 due to Covid-19 or EU Exit




A number of businesses continued to operate at reduced levels due to Covid-19 or EU Exit beyond the first three months of the year. Most businesses that increased activity in January-March due to Covid-19 continued to operate at increased levels after this period. Almost all businesses that temporarily ceased operations due to either Covid-19 or EU Exit during this period were mixed species or shellfish only sites.



# Change in Production Levels January-March 2021 & expected time to return to normal

Production levels compared to "normal" for the time of year (n=168)


If production levels abnormal, estimated time to return to normal production levels (n=54)



Some businesses reported reduced production levels in January-March 2021. Most of these businesses were either mixed species or shellfish only processing sites. Some specifically cited EU Exit as the reason for this reduction, while others did not. A few businesses reported an increase in production levels during this time, either due to EU Exit or for other reasons. Of those businesses that reported a change, one-third were unable to estimate when production levels would return to "normal". 40% expected production levels to return to "normal" within 12 months, while 13% either expected changes in production levels to be permanent or take more than 12 months to return to "normal".




# Changes to operations due to **Covid-19** since 1<sup>st</sup> of January 2021



38% of businesses reported changes in operations due to Covid-19 restrictions since 01 January 2021. The most cited changes were in Labour&Production including shift patterns and production lines (69%) and Sales&Distribution including routes to market (45%).




## Changes to operations due to **EU Exit** since 1<sup>st</sup> of January 2021




38% of businesses reported changes in operations due to EU Exit since 01 January 2021. The most cited changes were in Labelling on EU Exports, Sales&Distribution including changes to consignment size and frequency (52%), Transport Routes and Freight Services (47%) and Labour including hiring more staff (38%).



### Increase in export costs since 1st of January 2021




#### Changes to export consignments since 1st of January 2021



Nearly a quarter of respondents reported a change to consignments from 01 January 2021. 75% of these businesses reported a reduction in their consignments, while most of the rest stopped exporting all together. Of those that sent fewer consignments, 57% reported sending fewer but larger consignments due to EU Exit.
