2020 Import and export summary introduction



- This factsheet contains key facts relating to the UK's overall imports and exports of seafood
- The UK's total seafood trade decreased in 2020 in terms of value and volume, and the average £/kg fell
- Both seafood imports and exports decreased in value and volume, whilst experiencing deflation
- Imports' share of value trade increased to 67%, whilst it maintained 62% share of volume trade

This section contains key facts relating to the UK's seafood imports in 2020

- Seafood imports decreased in value and volume, whilst experiencing deflation
- The countries that import the largest value of seafood into the UK were Iceland, China, and Vietnam
- The value and volume of demersal, shellfish, and pelagic imports decreased. Whilst the average £/kg for demersal fell, it increased for shellfish and pelagic fish
- The species with the greatest import value were salmon, cod, and tuna
- A breakdown of the top 20 importing countries is provided for the key species groups, and the top 6 species




