



Responsible Fishing Ports Scheme: Documents to Support your Application

The pre-assessment stage of certification advises the submission of a range of policies and procedures along with the completed application form. You should try to provide as many of the documents listed in the table below. These documents relate to specific requirements (policies and procedures) in the RFPS Standard. Documents that may not be available in hard copy, or where there are confidentiality concerns, will be requested at the on-site audit. This will make the on-site assessment take longer to complete and likely result in increased cost. So, while providing all of these documents along with the application form is not mandatory, it is best to submit as many as possible with your application.
